STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

Claim of the System Committee that:

- "1) Carrier violated the agreement on June 2, 1983, when Trackman Raul Cantu, Kingsville Division, was not permitted to return to his position on Gang 5444 allegedly causing him to lose time during period May 16 through June 1, 1983.
- 2) Claimant shall now be paid eight hours each work day, plus overtime, for period May 16 through June 1, 1983, plus mileage to and from Riviera and Oden, Texas."


FINDINGS:

We are unable to find any violation of the Agreement when the Carrier abolished claimant's position as laborer on Patrol Gang 5444 and posted for bid a laborer position on Gang 5443 to achieve a realignment to meet it's work needs.
