Statement

of Claim: (1) Carrier violated Agreement Rule 12 when it issued a 7-day suspension from service against the personal record of Track Foreman T. D. James.


(2) Claimant James should now be paid for seven days' actual suspension plus one day for the investigation for a total of eight days at his regular rate of pay.


The Board has jurisdiction of this case.
