STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by failing to assign Bridge Derrick Operator J. E. O'Bannon to a vacancy in his class on December 15, 1958, but instead assigned a junior operator, F. L. Hamby.
- The Carrier compensate Bridge Derrick Operator J. E. O'Bannon for all wages lost because of the Carrier's violation of his seniority rights referred to in Part 1 of this Claim beginning December 15, 1958, and continuing until this violation of the Agreement is discontinued.

Disposition of this claim is governed by our Award No. 39. FINDINGS:
