STATEMENT

OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by failing to equip camp car of Extra Gang Foreman Robert Boswell, as provided in Rule 33.
- (2) Extra Gang Foreman Robert Boswell be reimbursed for actual expense incurred for meals and lodging during the month of December, 1957, in the amount of \$115.50 on account of this violation of the Agreement.

FINDINGS: The award in Case No. 41 governs disposition of this claim.

AWARD: Claim denied.
