Statement

- of Claim: (1) Carrier violated the Agreement, especially Rule 12, when Trackman T. M. Harris was dismissed on October 4, 1990.
  - (2) Claim on behalf of Mr. Harris for wage loss suffered, until reinstated with seniority, vacation and all other rights unimpaired.

Findings: The Board has jurisdiction of this case by reason of the parties Agreement establishing this Board therefor.

> The Claimant, Trackman T. M. Harris, following a formal investigation held on August 16 and 19, 1990 on the charge:

> "Your reporting for work under the influence of an alcoholic beverage, when working as a trackman on Gang 3533 at Prairie Du Rocher, IL."

> was found to be culpable. He was dismissed from service as discipline therefore.

> The Claimant was accorded the due process to which entitled under Rule 12.

> There was sufficient competent and probative evidence adduced to support the Carrier's conclusion of culpability.

> The discipline imposed for a Rule G violation of dismissal is found to not be unreasonable in this case.

Award: Claim denied.
