BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES
Versus
THE CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY OF NEW JERSEY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

1. The Carrier violated the effective Agreement on April 24, 1961, by assigning Grinder Butchko and his helper Herman, to work of tightening switch brackets on a switch near Allentown Passenger Station.
2. The two senior furloughed Track Laborers maintaining seniority on the Pennsylvania Division be now reimbursed in the amount of 8 hours each account of this Grinder and Grinder Helper being assigned to perform this Trackmen's work, referred to in part one of this claim.

OPINION OF BOARD:

The tightening of switch brackets is normally track maintenance work of the Trackmen's class. But where, as here, the tightening of switch brackets is performed by a Grinder and a Grinder Helper as incidental to switch grinding, no violation of the Trackmen's seniority occurs.

AWARD: Claim denied.
