- 1. Carrier violated the Agreement in failing and refusing to allow C. B. Bergeron, who was on vacation June 26 to July lh, 1957, inclusive, proper compensation in accordance with Agreement rules for such vacation period.
- 2. Carrier shall now be required to pay C. B. Bergeron, in addition to amount heretofore allowed, an additional sum equivalent to eight (8) hours at time and one-half prorate rate for such vacation period.
