## STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. (a) Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it required or permitted an employe or official, not covered by said Agreement, to transmit a message at Tunnel No. 7, West Virginia on November 25, 1959.
  - (b) Carrier shall be required to compensate Operator Paul Dowell in the amount of a day's pay (eight hours) on November 25, 1959.
- 2. (a) Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it required or permitted an employee or official, not covered by said Agreement, to transmit a message from Tunnel No. 11, West Virginia on March 11, 1960.
  - (b) Carrier shall be required to compensate Operator W. H. Davis in the amount of a day's pay (eight hours) on March 11, 1960.

## FINDINGS:

The facts in this claim and the type of conversation involved are similar to those in Docket No. 139.

For the reasons therein cited, a denial award is required here.
