STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it required or permitted a conductor on a work train engaged in maintenance service to receive and copy train order No. 71 at James, Indiana on May 9, 1957.
- 2. Carrier shall compensate an idle operator in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours) on this date.

FINDINGS:

This is another "station limits" claim.

So far as the factual record is concerned James, Indiana is .6 mile west of North Vernon.

Organization concedes North Vernon is a "station" insofar as Article 35 is concerned. Carrier states James is the name of a siding and it is definitely within the "station limits" of North Vernon, being .6 mile distant. Organization says it is not.

AWARD

Claim denied.
