- STATEMENT OF CLAIM:
1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when, on April 26, 1962 it required or permitted employees not covered by the Agreement to handle a message between Decatur, Illinois and Montezuma, Indiana.
 2. Carrier shall compensate Operator R. D. Collings in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours) on April 26, 1962.


