
STATEMENT OF CLAIM: 1. Carrier violated the agreement between the parties when on May 10 and 11, 1961, it required or permitted others outside the agreement to transmit and/or receive messages between Cowen and Grafton, West Virginia.

2. Carrier shall compensate two idle operators each in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours) on May 10, and 11, 1961.


