AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 259


STATEMENT OF CLAIM: 1 - Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when on May 24, 1960 it required or permitted employees outside the Agreement to communicate direct with the Train Dispatcher at Swanders, Ohio.

2 - Carrier shall compensate Operator W. V. Hetteshelmer in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours) on May 24, 1960.

FINDINGS: Because we believe that the setting out of a car from one train -- because of shifted cargo -- to be subsequently picked up by a local train for delivery to the next terminal, would have to become a matter of record, we will follow our Award in Docket No. 66 and sustain this claim.
