STATEMENT OF CLAIM: 1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it failed and refused to compensate Operator G. M. Miller properly for February 22, 1962.


2. Carrier shall compensate G. M. Miller in the amount of 8 hours pro rata for February 22, 1962.


FINDINGS: Claimant here was a regularly assigned employee. As such he qualifies for holiday pay by meeting one of two requirements.


The record shows he met the first of these requirements; compensation paid him by the Carrier was credited to the workdays immediately preceding and following the holiday in question. Despite Carrier argument he was not required to meet the second.


