STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

System Docket 262 - Philadelphia Region Case 15337 - "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Rules Agreement, effective May 1, 1942, except as amended, particularly Rule 2-A-1, and Paragraph III-2-B of Supplemental Agreement 'A', by unilaterally establishing a clerical position in the Car Distributor's Office at Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, Philadelphia Region, and appointing an individual to the position without regard to the various provisions of the Rules Agreement.
- (b) The Claimant, Clerk Lawrence Cirillo, should be allowed eight hours' pay a day, as a penalty, commencing October 5, 1956, and continuing until the violation is corrected."

FINDINGS:

Carrier's Manager, Labor Relations, in his letter denying the claim here before us, noted the claim had not been handled in accordance with Rule 7-B-1, and, accordingly, should "not be entertained nor allowed."

Its position is correct.

AWARD:

Claim dismissed.
