## STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(a) J. M. Hampton be assigned to position of Foreman, Mail Platform - 30th Street Station, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and be compensated for monetary loss sustained, retroactive to and including June 7, 1957, effective date on which he signified that he wished to displace a junior employe. (Docket 212)"

## FINDINGS:

Two facts present in this record require that a denial Award be issued.

- 1. Claimant's assignment to newly installed mail-handling equipment from April 15 to June 2, 1957 does not constitute experience in the wide range of a foreman's position despite the fact he was paid at the foreman's rate.
- Carrier did not exercise its right to determine the qualifications of this man in an arbitrary or capricious manner. This is amply proven by Carrier's exhibits F and G in this record.

The claim will be denied.

## AWARD:

Claim denied.
