AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 28

STATEMENT

OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(1) The Carrier violated the effective agreement by failing to assign Trackman L. C. Young, Extra Gang #15821, Wheeling Division, to overtime work on Saturday, September 23, and Monday, September 25, 1961, when, instead, a junior trackman was used.

(2) Trackman L. C. Young be now compensated for $5\frac{1}{2}$ hours pay for Saturday, September 23, and $4\frac{1}{2}$ hours pay for Monday, September 25, 1961, on account of the Carrier's violation of the agreement, referred to."

FINDINGS:

The claim of the Organization in this docket having been withdrawn, a dismissal award is in order.
