BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES
and
THE STATEN ISLAND RAPID TRANSIT RAILWAY COMPANY
AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 56

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by employing a contractor, outside parties, on Saturday and Sunday, June 23 and 24, 1962, to make changes in the partitions in the Carrier's Auditor's office at Victory Boulevard, Staten Island, New York.

(2) Carpenter Foreman G. D. Decker, Carpenters H. Schlaefer and William A. Decker be now reimbursed for one days' pay at their respective time and one-half rate, account of this violation of the Agreement."

FINDINGS: Because we believe the office space rented by the Carrier at 2 Victory Boulevard, Staten Island, is used to house Carrier employees whose daily functions are necessary to the proper function of this railroad, we will follow Award 4783 and sustain this claim.

AWARD: Claim sustained at pro rata only.
