STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

"Glaim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Reading Company, that:

Claim No. 1

- Carrier violated the parties Agreement by requiring or permitting an employe not covered thereby to handle a train order at Linfield, Pennsylvania, on August 9, 1961.
- 2. Carrier shall be required to compensate J. Dombroskie, senior idle extra employe, a day's pay (8 hours).

CLAIM No. 2

- 1. Carrier violated the parties' Agreement by requiring or permitting an employe not covered thereby to handle a train order at Cromby, Pennsylvania, on August 10. 1961.
- 2. Carrier shall be required to compensate W. R. Gracely, senior idle extra employe, a day's pay (8 hours)."

FINDINGS:

This docket involves the delivery of train orders to a Speno Cleaner train by telephone at points where no operators are employed. The situation is like that in Docket No. 3, so our Award No. 3 governs disposition of these claims.

AWARD:

Claims denied.
