## STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Reading Company, that:

- Carrier violated the parties' Agreement by permitting and/or requiring employes not covered thereby to perform work thereunder at Lyons, Pennsylvania, on August 3, 1962.
- Carrier shall pay the senior idle employe, extra in preference, a day's pay at the minimum rate on the Reading Division for August 3, 1962. Name of claimant to be determined by a joint check of Carrier's records."

FINDINGS:

This claim is based upon the delivery of a train order by radio-telephone from an operator at Reading to the conductor of a train stopped at a red signal indication, account of a disabled train ahead. No operator is employed at that point. There is no difference in principle between delivery by telephone and by radio-telephone, so the disposition of this claim is governed by our Award No. 3.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
