- "1. The Reading Company violated our current Agreement when it required and/or permitted, an employee (Clerk J. Beatty) not under the scope of our Agreement, to perform communications of record work, on Thursday, December 3, 1964, at West Trenton Station.
 - 2. Account of the above violation, the Reading Company is required to pay to Claimant D. L. Kisielis, a "call" as provided for under Article 8 (a) of our current Agreement, for two (2) separate violations on this date, for a total of \$16.6368 (includes \$.09 per hour increase that was retroactive to January 1, 1964).
- 3. Account of the above violation, the Reading Company is required to pay to Claimant D. L. Kisielis, whatever interest may be due him at time claim is finally settled. Amount to be determined at the daily prevailing rate of interest being paid by Federal banks in Mr. Kisielis' home area."
