THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS

VS.

READING COMPANY

STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Reading Company, that:

1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it required or permitted an employe not covered by the Agreement to handle a train order at Rock on August 2, 1960.
2. Carrier shall be required to compensate R. Short, Extra Telegrapher, in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours)."

FINDINGS:

Rock is an unattended interlocking remotely controlled by FS tower at West Falls. No telegrapher has ever been assigned there. The situation is like that involved in Docket No. 3, so our Award No. 3 governs decision herein.

AWARD: Claim denied.
