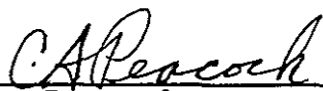
STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

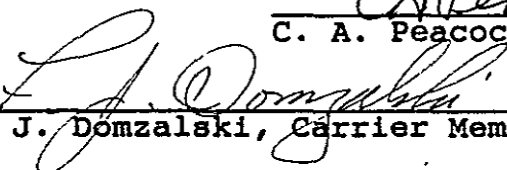

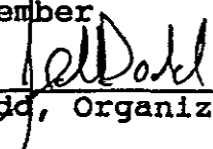
