QUESTION  
AT ISSUE:

Claim on behalf of L. F. Kramer for the rate of the position he was working October 1, 1964, from the time he was reduced (in July, 1965), to a lower-rated position until he is returned to his former position or a higher-rated position.

OPINION  
OF BOARD:

Claimant was a protected employe on October 1, 1964. Under the facts of this docket he is entitled to have his compensation preserved at the rate of the position occupied on that date under the terms of Article IV, Section 1.

Because of the unique facts and circumstances of this award there is no intent to establish a precedent.

AWARD

Claim sustained.
