QUESTIONS
AT ISSUE:

(1) Did the Carrier violate the terms of Article III, Section 1 of the February 7, 1965 Agreement at Battle Creek, Michigan, when on March 1, 1968, it arbitrarily and unilaterally transferred certain clerical work from Seniority District No. 2 to the Seniority Districts Nos. 1 and 4 without conference and agreement with the Organization?

(2) Shall the Carrier be required to compensate G. E. Latta and D. Miller for two (2) hours' pay at the time and one-half rate of the positions to which assigned for March 1, 1968, and each subsequent day until such time as the violation has been corrected by the return of the work to the seniority district from which removed?


OPINION
OF BOARD:

On March 1, 1968, the Carrier transferred certain clerical work from Seniority District No. 2, to Seniority District Nos. 1 and 4, at Battle Creek, Michigan. Thereafter, the Organization alleged a violation of Article III, of the February 7, 1965 National Agreement, in that the Carrier failed to enter into an Implementing Agreement.

Inasmuch as only transfer of work was involved herein, we believe that Award Nos. 43 and 124, are dispositive of the issues.

AWARD

The answer to Questions (1) and (2) is in the negative.
